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## Registration & Match Fees Explained – 2017

We would like to take this opportunity to explain what your registration and match payment fees go towards. We do understand that the cost of registration can be expensive and assure you we keep the costs to a minimum. The Club is run as a not for profit with all proceeds being used for the benefit of all Club members.

Unlike many other sporting codes, participation in football in NSW receives NO subsidisation of any description – from the state or national bodies. Clubs (and CCF) must ensure that the running costs are covered through registration fees, sponsorship, canteen revenue and fund-raising. Each Club will have a different fee structure dependant on their ground fees (if they have them), sponsorship income or other funds they may have. Here are just some of the areas that we as a Club need to spend money on in to ensure that we can all play football each week.

Ground Hire for 4 fields \* Referee Fees \* Trial Game Venue Hire \* Playing Shirts \* Match & Training Balls \* Bibs/Cones/Nets/Corner Flags \* Coaching Costs \* End of Season Gifts & Trophies \* Presentation Costs \* Line Marking Paint \* Audit and Bank Fees \* Internet \* Electronic devices \* Electricity \* Other Admin Costs \* Stationery/Postage \* Cleaning products \* Subscriptions \* Gala Days for Junior Teams

On top of this we must budget for future capital expenditure such at the new change rooms and canteen facility at Kurraba and allow for enough money in the bank for the Club to remain solvent and in a comfortable financial position. If we fail to do this there will be no Berkeley Vale Soccer Club.

All the Clubs volunteers get paid nil and gain nil financial benefit for volunteering. The Clubs financials are audited by an external Accounting firm and every piece of income and expenditure has to be accounted for. There are policies in place to allow for separation of duties so that any takings and expenses are reconciled and authorised by at least two different, unrelated people. A list of all expenditure is usually circulated at each committee meeting which all members are welcome and encouraged to attend.

The table below shows a full breakdown of the fees we as a Club pay to the regulatory bodies for each age group. Alongside you will see a breakdown of the different cost groups allocated to each player registration to hopefully give you an idea of the real cost per player of playing football. You will note the negative figure of more than \$80,000, the player match fees payments cover less than 25% of this. The rest as mentioned earlier has to be covered by fundraising, sponsorship and canteen. The best way to keep your registration fees to a minimum is to get involved with helping with some of these activities.
